



## SECURITY CHECKS

**Everything indicated below will have to be ready and available for immediate inspection starting from 10 am on Thursday April 7, 2022.**

- Inflatable liferaft with a total capacity to accommodate at least the number of people on board and the related certificate
- 2 anchors meeting the size recommended for the boat's dimensions with suitable combination of chain and rope, ready for immediate deployment
- 1 life jacket for each crew member + 1 spare, with: crotch/thigh straps, sprayhood, waterproof emergency position indicating light, whistle
- 1 safety harness for each crew member + 1 spare with a tether that shall not exceed 2 mt including an intermediate and an end self-closing hook
- 1 fire blanket
- 2 fire extinguishers, each with minimum 2 kg of dry powder, in opposite parts of the boat
- 1 first aid kit.
- 1 shears (cutter) able to disconnect or sever the standing rigging from the boat
- 1 grab bag (readily accessible whether or not the boat is inverted) with the following minimum contents: 1 watertight hand-held marine VHF transceiver with spare batteries, 1 watertight flashlight with spare batteries and bulbs, 1 watertight strobe light with spare batteries, 3 red hand flares, 1 knife
- 4 red hand flares
- 2 orange smoke flares
- 1 strong, sharp knife, sheathed and securely restrained on deck or cockpit
- 1 storm or 1 heavy weather jib, in good condition, with highly visible colour pink, orange or yellow inserts and with double attach to the stay
- 1 storm trysail if the mainsail reefing does not allow to reduce the luff by at least 40%
- Tapered soft wood plugs stowed adjacent to every through-hull opening
